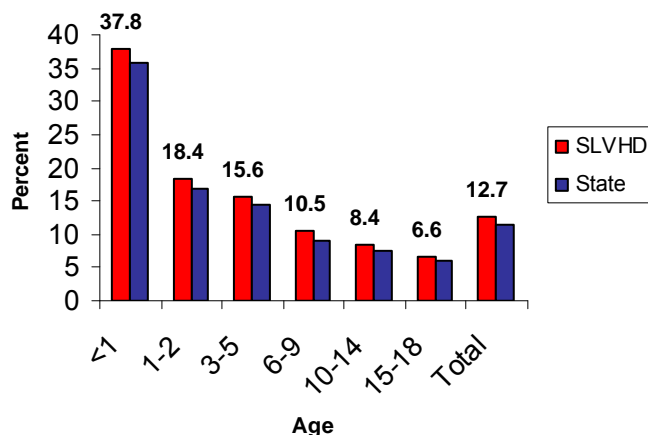

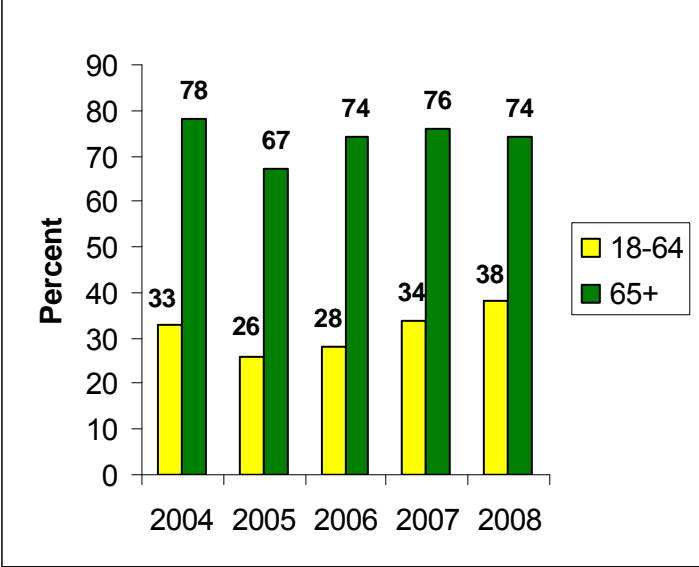

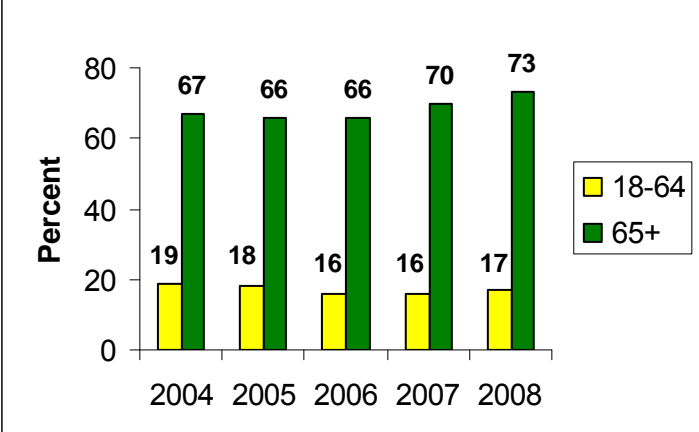
**Influenza\* Vaccinations 2004-2008<sup>15</sup>**
